



Mercure Hotel Sydney Airport “Airport Dash” Online Competition: Terms and Conditions:

Information on how to enter the Promotion forms part of these terms and conditions. Entries not made in accordance with these terms and conditions will be disqualified.

Section 1: Competition

1. Competition: Play our “Airport Dash” Online Competition and register to be eligible to win instant and weekly prizes, and to go into the draw to win the Major Prize.

2.Promoter: Rockdale Hotel Pty Ltd (ABN 54 59 6642 844) trading as Mercure Hotel Sydney Airport of 20 Levey Street, Wolli Creek, NSW 2205

3.Competition Period: The Competition will commence at 12.01 am on 13 August and will close at 11.59 pm on 5 October. All times recorded throughout these terms and conditions are both Australian Daylight Saving time and Australian Eastern Standard time.

Section 2: Eligibility

1. Eligibility To be eligible to enter the Competition, the entrant must:

- (a) be above 18 years of age
- (b) be an Australian resident
- (c) played the online game Mercure Hotel Sydney Airport “ Airport Dash” and successfully completed by making it to the online version of Mercure Hotel Sydney Airport.

2. Non-Eligibility

3.Further, any personal information or contact details entered incorrectly on the online enquiry form shall deem the entry as an invalid entry.

Section 3: Entry to the Competition

1.To enter, an Eligible Entrant must use a compatible browser to visit the Competition Website: [www. Mercuresydneyairport.com.au/airportdash](http://www.Mercuresydneyairport.com.au/airportdash) and play the game “Airport Dash”.To be successful in the game and be eligible to win one of the Prizes, the entrant has to overcome the obstacles in the airport and be able to make his way to the online version of Mercure Hotel Sydney Airport. 2. Internet Entries

2. Eligible Entrants must make their Internet entries manually using an Internet browser. The Promoter may reject Internet entries if the Promoter reasonably forms the opinion that they have been entered using automated entry means.

Section 4: Draw

1. Draw: The promoter will conduct a random draw of all submitted entries at 5 pm on 12 October 2007 at 20 Levey Street, Wolli Creek, NSW 2205. The Prize Winners will be selected at random from a computer-generated listing of entries that comply with Section 2 and Section 3.

2.
